Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

1. 3,250 L.F. of 8-inch Sewer Main
2. 12 Manholes
3. Reconnecting existing services

A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Hooks, Texas or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin.

The City of Hooks, Texas reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by City of Hooks, Texas for a period not to exceed 30 / 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.
