

NOTICE TO BIDDERS OF THE INTENTION OF THE QUEEN CITY EDC TO RECEIVE COST PROPOSALS FOR STREET CONSTRUCTION AT THE QC EDC PROPERTY ON HIGHWAY 59.

SEALED QUOTES addressed to the Queen City EDC, City of Queen City, 601 Loop 236, Queen City, Texas 75572, will be received until 2 P.M., March 15, 2022 for furnishing all labor, equipment, materials, supplies, and supervision necessary for the construction of streets to include grading, base installation, curb installation, and asphalt pavement. Bid Proposals will be publicly received at the City, and read aloud at such time at the City Hall.

PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS may be examined without charge at A.L. Franks Engineering Office located at 118 E Broad St, Texarkana, Arkansas and the City Hall at Queen City. A CERTIFIED OR CASHIER'S CHECK, or an acceptable bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid shall accompany each bid as a guaranty that, if awarded the contract, the bidder will promptly enter into contract with the Queen City EDC and furnish bonds on the forms provided.

THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER OR BIDDERS will be required to furnish a Performance and Payment Bond, each in the amount of the contract, written by a responsible surety company authorized to do business in the State of Texas that is satisfactory to the Owner.

BIDDERS ARE expected to inspect the site of the work and to inform themselves of all local conditions. The time of completion shall be 60 calendar days including Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IN EMPLOYMENT: All qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

NO BID may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least 60 calendar days.

IN CASE of ambiguity or lack of clearness stating the price in the bids, the City of Queen City reserves the right to consider the most advantageous construction thereof, or to reject the bid.

THE CITY OF QUEEN CITY reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive any minor informalities, and to award the contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

CONTRACTORS are cautioned that unqualified bids will be subject to rejection.

CONTRACTORS are specifically advised that any person, firm, or other party to whom it is proposed to award a subcontract under this contract must be acceptable to the Owner.
